Submission of Papers

Prospective authors are invited to submit short papers of up to two pages in length and in double-column format, which describe their research and results through the GSRC online submission system. Eligibility & Copyright

To be eligible, the first author must be a graduate student at a higher education institution in the UAE in Academic Year 2020-2021, an Emirati graduate student enrolled at an international institution or an invited student. Select senior undergraduate students at UAE universities are also encouraged to submit papers. Conference participation is free of charge to all students.

Copyright of all papers submitted to UAE GSRC remains with the authors. This means authors are free to publish their work in other conferences or journals.

Optional Conference Proceedings

The authors of the short papers that are accepted and presented at the UAE GSRC 2021 will be invited to submit an extended version of their papers for publication in separate proceedings that will be produced after the conference. The submission of extended papers is optional and has no impact on the participation in GSRC 2021.
